

COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS

Community planning is a decision-making activity that introduces change. Stakeholders include members of the community who effect this change and those who are affected by such changes. In effect, every citizen of Houston County and the cities of Centerville, Perry and Warner Robins is considered a stakeholder in the comprehensive plan process. In order to insure sufficient representation and input from the widest spectrum of stakeholders, a preliminary list of targeted individuals was compiled that identified persons and groups to be directly included in implementation of the comprehensive planning process. This list is not intended to be static. It is designed to incorporate the inclusion of anyone who expresses interest on being added to it at any point in the planning process.

In creating this extensive list, the Community Planning Committee (CPC) considered individuals representing many areas of interest throughout the community. Included in the list are state and local elected officials, state and local government staff, representatives from private businesses, civic and faith based organizations, education, healthcare, public safety, industry, and planning. In addition, the list includes specifically identified contacts with Robins Air Force Base, as well as persons conversant with transportation, economic, housing, environmental, and social issues, programs and initiatives. Truly comprehensive in nature, this list and the individuals included on it will be utilized during the comprehensive planning process as described in the schedule for completing the Community Agenda.
